LRT BUILD Apprenticeship Preparatory Program

The LRT BUILD Program is a **10-week apprenticeship preparatory program** that will prepare you for an exciting and well-paid career in the construction industry. This program offers graduates the opportunity to meet with unions and contractors working on the Southwest Light Rail Transit (Metro Green Line Extension) Project. Attend an upcoming session on **June 5**.

To participate in the LRT BUILD program, you must:

- Be at least 18 years old
- Have received a H.S. Diploma/GED or be scheduled to graduate from high school by June 2017
- Possess a valid driver's license by the end of the 10-week program
- NOT already enrolled in a Construction Union

Is Apprenticeship the Right Choice?

Minnesota's apprenticeship system offers an opportunity for a person with limited job skills to enter a high-wage industry, gaining experience and salary increases through on-the-job training and classroom instruction. The earn-while-you-learn system enables individuals to move to the top of the wage scale in three to five years.

- **Private College:** Students **pay** \$133K (The average cost of four-year private college tuition in Minnesota.).
- **Public College:** Students **pay** \$29K (The average cost of four-year state university tuition in Minnesota.).
- **Apprenticeship:** Students **earn** \$144K (Average wages earned by an apprentice during four years of on-the-job training.).

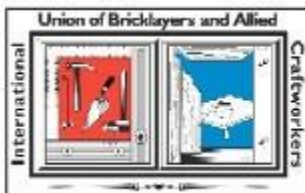
