

Plumbing Apprenticeship Program Notice

Dear Sir or Madam:

The St. Paul Plumbers Local 34 Joint Apprenticeship program is operated on an equal opportunity basis. This notice is being sent for informational purposes to aid potential apprentice applicants.

You can apply for the Plumbing Program at Saint Paul College, 235 Marshall Ave St. Paul, MN 55102. Applicants must pass the assessment test at Saint Paul College to be eligible to interview for the program. The assessment test is given Monday through Friday on a walk in basis.

BASIC QUALIFICATIONS APPLICANTS

The applicant must be at least 18 years of age and shall have a high school diploma or a G.E.D. Applicants must pass the Saint Paul College assessment test with the accepted Plumbing Program scores.

Eligible applicants, who are found to meet all of the above basic requirements, will be given the opportunity for an oral interview. You will be notified by letter of the date, time, and place of the oral interview.

Selection of apprentices for the plumbing apprenticeship is based on descending order of rank determined by the score achieved on the assessment test and oral interview.


Interviews will be held in the fall for the Spring Semester start. Test scores must be submitted by September 30th for and interview in the fall.

The number of selected applicants shall be based on the needs of the industry in the jurisdiction of L.U. 34. Applicants may be subject to a pre-employment drug test.

The selection of apprentices is made without regard to race, age, religion, sex or national origin.
