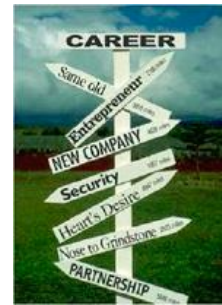

ACCESS TO MORE JOBS AND TRAINING

If you live in public housing or if your household income falls below the income limits, you may qualify for training and employment opportunities. A rule called Section 3 creates this opportunity for jobs and training opportunities for HUD funded construction related projects.

This project is a collaboration between the following jurisdictions:

If you reside within one of these jurisdictions and meet the eligibility criteria, then you can register as a Section 3 Resident at tcsection3.org
